Q What's your advice to associates?

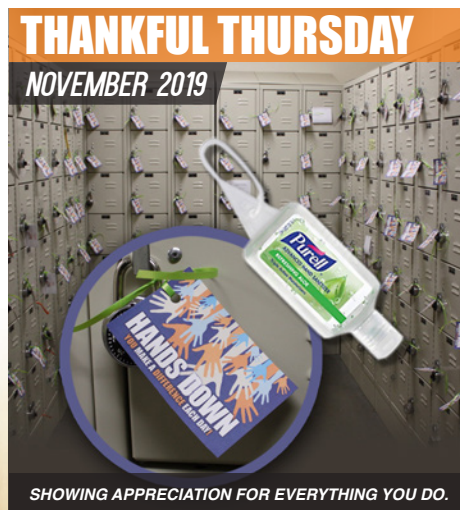
A *Understand that this is a job, you can have fun and still front and face/packdown your departments.*
