Associate Support Department Supervisor (ASDS) are the central point of contact for store associates and provide direct support to the store leadership team. ASDSs are responsible for developing associate schedules and for assisting with hourly staffing, orientation and training processes. They assist with timely completion of hourly performance reviews and support the Store Manager in hourly succession planning. ASDSs coordinate service and recognition awards. They also support a productive work environment by ensuring maintenance on the hiring kiosk, break room, training room and communication boards. They are also responsible for ensuring that hourly HR records are properly sent to the HRSC. Due to the sensitivity of information handled, ASDSs must maintain strict confidentiality. ASDSs report directly to the Store Manager, with dotted-line reporting to the District Human Resources Manager.
